



## The PRT Scheme

### *TRAINER REQUIREMENTS*

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Trainers are required to meet certain requirements before approval can be given as a Trainer. There is an application form to be completed, but the main Trainer requirements are:

- 3 years experience as a chiropractor
- 2 years experience in the practice from which the Trainer is applying
- Willingness to become a member of the College of Chiropractors if not already a member
- GCC registration
- Continuing clinical competence – completion of annual Continuing Professional Development is evidence of this.
- Suitability to have responsibility for guiding a junior colleague.
- All Trainers must have their working systems and practice open to review as part of the selection system in operation. In certain circumstances, the College's PRT Committee may ask to undertake a practice visit.
- Attend at least one Trainers' Forum every three years. Meetings are from 2.00pm to 6.00pm. The venue for 2006 is: **Trinity & All Saints College, Leeds, Thursday 13th July 2006.** Please contact College House if you would like to attend the above meeting. Other dates to follow.
